Recommended Vaccination Programs

Puppy and Adult Dog Program

We recommend that all dogs be vaccinated against:

- Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parvovirus, Parainfluenza (DHPP/DHLPP)
- Bordetella (Kennel Cough)
- Rabies
- Flu

Other vaccines available for dogs in high-risk areas:

- Lyme's Disease
- Rattlesnake Venom

*Certain breeds may require an additional Parvovirus vaccine as recommended by our doctors. (Rottweilers, Dobermans, Etc.)

Puppy Program	
8 weeks	DHPP or DHLPP, Deworming, Fecal Test
12 weeks	DHPP or DHLPP, Bordetella, Flu, Rabies, Deworming, Fecal Test
16 weeks	DHPP or DHLPP, Bordetella #2, Flu, Rabies #2, Deworming, Fecal Test
20 weeks	Rattlesnake, Lyme
24 weeks	Rattlesnake, Lyme

These vaccinations should be boosted 1 year later. Heartworm prevention should be started prior to 16 weeks of age. Heartworm testing is done at 1 year of age.

Adult Dog Program	
Annual	Lepto, Bordetella, Flu, Heartworm Test, Deworming, Fecal Test
Every Spring	Rattlesnake, Lyme,
3-years	DHPP or DHLPP, Rabies

Annual examination is required. No vaccine can be given within 2 weeks of any other vaccine. Boosters must be given within 4-6 weeks of original vaccination.

Kitten and Adult Cat Program

We recommend that all cats be vaccinated against:

- Panleukopenia, Calicivirus, Rhinotracheitis virus (FVRCP)
 - Affords distemper and viral cold protection
- Rabies
- Feline Leukemia/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FELV/FIV) Testing
- Feline Leukemia/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FELV/FIV) Testing
 - Recommended no sooner than 12 weeks of age

*We recommended testing be done prior to vaccination; upon a negative test result, the FELV Vaccine is recommended.

Kitten Program	
8 weeks	FVRCP, Deworming, Fecal Test
12 weeks	FVRCP, Rabies, FELV/FIV Test, FELV Vaccine, Deworming, Fecal Test
16 weeks	FVRCP, FELV Vaccine, Deworming, Fecal Test

These vaccinations should be boosted 1 year later. Heartworm prevention should be started prior to 16 weeks of age.

Adult Cat Program	
Annual	Rabies, Deworming, Fecal Test
Biennial	FELV Vaccine
3-years	FVRCP

Annual examination is required. No vaccine can be given within 2 weeks of any other vaccine. Boosters must be given within 6 weeks of original vaccination.
